Annex B

Licensing Conditions for Licence to Supply Explosives

1. The licensee shall only supply the explosive types specifically authorised in the licence.
2. The licensee shall maintain comprehensive stock records containing:
 - a) Transaction details
 - i. Date of stock receipt
 - ii. Import licence number or supplier details
 - iii. Explosive descriptions
 - iv. Quantities sold, exported, or transferred
 - v. Purchaser or export licence numbers
 - b) All stock and sales records shall be maintained for a minimum period of:
 - i. 10 years for high-risk explosives
 - ii. 3 years for lower-risk explosives
3. The licensee shall store explosives exclusively in storage facilities approved by the Licensing Officer. This requirement extends to temporary storage arrangements pending delivery or during transportation security arrangements.
4. The licensee shall ensure that during transportation or supply of explosives:
 - a) Joint inspections are conducted:
 - i. Prior to transportation commencement
 - ii. Upon arrival at the approved destination
 - b) All inspections and transfers are properly documented and endorsed by relevant parties including:
 - i. The licensee
 - ii. The sender

iii. The recipient

5. The licensee shall:

- a) Obtain prior approval from the Licensing Officer for all prospective employees handling explosives through the GoBusiness System by submitting Security Clearance application for Special Workers
- b) Restrict explosive handling to approved personnel only
- c) Notify the Licensing Officer within seven days of any employee cessation through the GoBusiness System

6. The licensee shall provide minimum seven days' notice to the Licensing Officer regarding any business address changes.

7. The licensee shall immediately notify the Police of:

- a) Any explosive loss
- b) Unauthorised access to approved storage facilities
- c) Unauthorised attempts to participate in explosive transportation
- d) Any security or safety incidents

8. The licensee shall facilitate inspections by the Licensing Officer or authorised officers, who may:

- a) Access licensed premises
- b) Inspect premises and explosives
- c) Document through photographs, films, records, or sketches
- d) Request access to relevant documents or articles
- e) Copy or extract from documents
- f) Take possession of documents or articles when:
 - i. Inspection cannot reasonably be performed on-site
 - ii. Risk of interference or destruction exists

iii. Items may be required as evidence
